- 4. A demonstrated ability to implement the endorsed recommendations of the SCSA review and creatively respond to growing the association
- 5. Strong interpersonal skills to communicate at all levels of an organisation.
- 6. Outstanding organisation skills and a readiness to drive the operations of the association
- 7. A demonstrated ability to facilitate a high level of delivery of sporting competitions inclusive of increased participation for member schools
- 8. Sound judgment and the ability to operate autonomously, and demonstrated initiative and innovative thinking in dealing with issues in a decisive and consistent manner.
- 9. Leadership skills that reflect an ability to lead new initiatives and build a strong culture of sports participation across the member schools
- 10. Personal qualities such as confidence, flexibility, initiative, loyalty, perseverance and resourcefulness necessary to contribute to the growth of the SCSA
- 11. Current Victorian Working with Children Check or VIT
- 12. Demonstrated strategic capabilities such as goal-setting and change management. In particular, the ability to implement and drive effective change as required
- 13. Exhibit diligence and commitment to all aspects of employment including areas such as child-safe practice, professional presentation and behaviour, self-assessment, observing confidentiality expectations, approach to and completion of tasks within required timeframes
